

# Constructing a Performance Task Scenario (G.R.A.S.P.S.)

Consider the following set of stem statements as you construct a scenario for a performance task.

### Goal :

- Your task is to describe how would you feel if you had to move <sup>to live</sup> by a positive
- The goal is to Compare how you would feel to the way Pollyanna feels
- The problem/challenge is Pollyanna had to go live with her aunt ~~bc~~ her dad died
- The obstacle(s) to overcome is (are) to help Pollyanna to get use to her new home

### Role:

- You are a new comer and you befriend Pollyanna
- You have been asked to describe to Pollyanna her new home
- Your job is to share what you new about Pollyanna's aunt

### Audience:

- Your client(s) is (are) Pollyanna who is moving to her aunt's house
- The target audience is Affraid, sad, unsure at where she is going
- You need to convince her that she is gonna be fine and going to learn to love her new home.

### Situation:

- The context you find yourself in is Pollyanna is moving to her aunt's house & her dad is <sup>passing</sup> away
- The challenge involves dealing with you helping Pollyanna get use to her new place by describing good thing about moving to a new place

### Product/Performance and Purpose:

- You will create a letter describing good thing about moving to another place in order to describe Pollyanna's new home
- You need to develop your ideas according to what you know about the aunt's house so that it becomes easier for Pollyanna to understand get to know her aunt's place

### Standards & Criteria for Success:

- Your performance needs to have a letter structure
- Your work will be judged by how clear your ideas are presented & how clear your description is from the free
